



BARRELS FOR ANGELS -- RULES & REGULATIONS

CONTESTANT ENTRIES

- Pre-entries are accepted with deadlines.
- Online pre-entries accepted via our website www.luckylottoevents.com with a deadline of May 24, 2024 for all classes.
- After May 24, 2024 all entries will be ON SITE AT EVENT ONLY! *No call in or text entries will be taken due to full time work schedules and poor service area.*
- All draws both pre-entry and on site will be drawn through event staff.
- A \$10 non-refundable fee will apply to any horse and/or rider changes and must be made through the entry office before run is made.
- On site entries close for classes as follows: Sweepstakes race entries close Friday 05/31/2024 at 7:00pm, Senior Sweepstakes entries close Saturday 06/01/2024 at 9:30am to allow time to complete and post draw; Youth Sweepstakes entries close Sunday 06/02/2024 at 9:30am to allow time to complete and post draw; Open 4D entries close last 25 runners of each day.

REFUNDS / LATE FEES

- ***NO ENTRY (INCLUDING VET OUTS) OR STALL/RV REFUNDS EFFECTIVE THURSDAY NIGHT 05/30/2024 AT MIDNIGHT***
- There are **NO LATE FEES** for on-site entries.
- If a contestant has to withdraw from competition before the refund deadline shown on May 30, 2024 75% of the entry fees will be refunded less office fees and any credit card fees applied thru entries.
- Refunds prior to the race deadline, will be mailed out to the contestant by Monday, June 10, 2024 along with checks not picked up on site.

STALL & RV RENTAL / TIE OUTS / SHAVINGS

- Stall and RV hook ups may be reserved via online or mail in reservation form. These forms are located on the website at www.luckylottoevents.com.
- Stalls and RV hook ups are available to rent first come first serve at a rate of \$25.00 per night.
- Limited stud stalls are available on site but it is the responsibility of the contestant to advise when a stud stall is needed.
- Dirt stalls located by the warm up arena will be filled first followed by the asphalt based stalls.
- Tie outs are allowed in designated areas only with a (1) time fee of \$20 per trailer. Tie out fees will be donated to East Texas Angel Network.
- ***ABSOLUTELY NO TIE OUTS ALLOWED IN THE RV AREA; NO HORSES ARE TO BE TIED TO STALLS FOR ANY REASON.***
- Shavings must be purchased on site \$8 per bag; No outside shavings allowed
- If found bringing in shavings, contestant will be required to pay \$8 for each bag.
- No refunds after Thursday, May 30, 2024 at midnight.

RACE FORMAT

- All formats based on age of contestant as January 1, 2024. Proof of age will be required if questioned.
- Sweepstakes race is an open, 2D divisional race with ½ second splits, Open to all contestants and horses of any age; No roll over
- Senior Sweepstakes race is 3D divisional race with ½ second splits, open to seniors ages 50 & over; Roll over option to open 4D and applicable senior side pots on Saturday.
- Youth Sweepstakes race is 3D divisional race with ½ second splits, open to youth ages 19 & Under (to allow WCRA nomination); Roll over option to open 4D and applicable youth events including anyone age eligible for the 8&Under on Sunday.
- Open 4D race is a 4D format with divisional splits of 1/2 – 1/2 – whole second splits (EX: 16.0/16.5/17.0/18.0)
- Young Champions 8 & Under race is 4D format with divisional splits of 1/2 – 1/2 – whole second splits (EX: 16.0/16.5/17.0/18.0);
- Young Champions **UNASSISTED** have the option to roll over to Open 4D & Youth incentives each day. Young Champion contestants may be led if needed for safety but will be unable to roll times over if so. There is no time requirements to participate only age requirements.
- Incentive Side Pots – 4D format with divisional splits of ½ - ½ - whole second splits (EX: 16.0/16.5/17.0/18.0) except WPRA & 5D side pots.
- Incentive Side Pot classifications are: Youth (Ages 17 & Under) Adult (Ages 18-49) Senior (Ages 50 & Over) 5D Incentive (Open to All)
- Contestant **MUST ENTER** the open 4D race or the 8&under race to have the option of entering the incentive side pots.
- Sweepstakes race contestants will be ran on Friday night and will not be eligible for roll over to open; We will drag every 3 runners.
- Futurity side pot will be horses age 5 & under as of January 1, 2024 and have not competed prior to November 15, 2023
- Event is BBR, WPRA & Arkansas Elite sanctioned; Paperwork will be provided at entry office; It is the responsibility of contestant to pay any fees and complete any required paperwork for each sanction.

AVERAGE RACE

- Average races for both open 4D race and youth incentive race.
- Contestants **MUST DECLARE THE HORSE** entered in the average race before their run on Saturday.
- Horse must be ran in the position drawn with the same contestant or it will result in a disqualification.
- If contestant is caught changing horses after their first run is made, it will be automatic disqualification from average race.
- Average entries will not be accepted on Sunday.
- Average will be calculated by adding the two runs together on the designated horse and dividing by 2.
- Average will be 4D format with divisional splits of ½ - ½ - whole second splits (EX: 16.0/16.5/17.0/18.0)
- Prizes will be awarded for division champions in the Average race; If contestant wins more than one division, only one jacket will be ordered and all divisions will be placed on jacket
- In the event of a tie, prizes will be determined by coin flip; If contestant is not on site for coin toss, producer will flip on their behalf.

FUTURITY SIDEPOUT

- Futurity eligibility open to horses of all breeds foaled 2019 or later (ages 5 years and younger)
- Horses must not have competed or won any money prior to November 15, 2023.
- A copy of registration papers must accompany futurity entry.
- Entry fee \$100 per horse per day.
- 2D divisional format each day with ¾ second splits
- No entry refunds after Thursday, May 30, 2024 at midnight; Only 75% will be refunded prior to deadline.
- Futurity payout will be made payable to the contestant entered in the race. Any prizes will be awarded to the contestant.

AWARDS

- Prizes will be on display in the office area as well as a detailed list of how they will be awarded.
- Contestant does not have to be present to receive awards. However, it is encouraged and appreciated for sponsor pictures, etc.
- In the event of a tie, prizes will be determined by a coin toss. If contestant is not on site, the producer will flip the coin on their behalf.
- If contestant is not on site and prizes have to be shipped, contestant will be responsible for any shipping costs for prizes.

PAYOUT

- **ALL CHECKS FOR SATURDAY & SUNDAY EXCEPT OPEN & YOUTH SWEEPSTAKES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED SUNDAY**
- Total number places paid in each category for all races except the sweepstakes race, will be based on total number of entries and will be calculated on BBR payout scale.
- Open Sweepstakes race is 90% payback with 100% of added money (\$1000 added) and paid according to number of entries
- Youth & Senior Sweepstakes race is 85% payback with 100% of added money (if applicable) and paid according to number of entries; Limited to 100 entries
- Average race is 80% payback with 100% of added money if any added and based on BBR payout scale.
- Open 4D race is 80% payback with 100% of added money and based on BBR payout scale.
- Youth, Adult & Senior incentive side pots are 80% payback with no added money and based on BBR payout scale.
- The Young Champions is 80% payback with 100% added money (if any added) and based on BBR payout scale.
- In the event of a tie, the payout will be split evenly between contestants; Prizes determined by the flip of a coin
- If contestant is not on site, the producer will represent them in the coin flip.
- Contestants will be paid out at the end of the race on Saturday and Sunday.
- Contestants must complete a W-9 form in full before checks will be released.
- Payout will be in check form and made payable to contestant. Contestant has 60 days to deposit winnings or check will be void.
- Contestants may make specific arrangements for checks to be picked up but must complete a form at the entry office designating the individual to release payment to. Otherwise, payment will be mailed.
- It is the contestant's responsibility to make sure we have complete name, mailing address, social security number and contact phone and/or email.

- **NOTE: CONTESTANT CHECKS NOT PICKED UP AT THE EVENT WILL BE MAILED OUT BY**

- **PLEASE MAKE ARRANGEMENTS TO HAVE SOMEONE PICK UP WINNINGS IF NEEDED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE RACE!**

WPRA SIDEPOTS

- Contestant must be a current member of the WPRA or JR WPRA to enter the WPRA incentive side pots and it is the responsibility of the contestant to provide all member number information to the registration office at time of entry.
- WPRA side pot will have \$250 added money to Saturday side pot with \$35 entry fee and is paid on a straight open pay (non-divisional) per WPRA; Contestants may only enter once per day; WPRA incentive race will be paid out on site.

RESULTS

***** ALL CONTESTANTS PLEASE MAKE NOTE *****

- Results of the division placings in the open and incentive races each day will be photographed, included on the live video feed and placed on our Facebook group page at "Lucky Lotto Barrels for Angels." A complete list of results will be posted including payout after the entire event is over, verified and complete with all information. These will be posted by June 10, 2024 on the website at www.luckylottoevents.com.

DRESS CODE / EVENT T-SHIRTS

- Dress code will be enforced for all competitions May 31-June 2, 2024. Dress code will not be required for exhibitions.
- Contestants must wear hat or helmet, long sleeve shirt, long pants, boots or western riding shoes.
- ***ALL SWEEPSTAKES race contestants must be in full dress code including hats (or helmets); Event T-Shirt exception does not apply for Sweepstakes contestants.***
- ***NOTE: The Open 4D long sleeve shirt and hat/helmet rule may only be waived if contestant is wearing an UNALTERED Barrels for Angels event T-Shirt.*** These are available for purchase thru our online order entry form at www.luckylottoevents.com. A very limited supply of T-Shirts will be available for purchase on site until sold out. No other T-Shirts or short sleeves allowed during the contestant's run.
- If contestant is not in dress code as described above, it will result in a disqualification.

COMPETITION RACE

TIMER / TIMER MALFUNCTION

- Electronic timers will be used and will be marked and staked in order to ensure the same pattern both days of competition.
- No reruns will be offered to contestants if penalties were incurred on their first run. Therefore, no reruns for contestants with a knocked down barrel, broken pattern, etc.
- In the event the electronic eyes malfunction and contestant has a clean run, contestant will be given the option of a rerun at their discretion on a fresh drag.
- If a contestant chooses not to rerun, they will receive a no time. Fees will not be refunded.
- If a contestant hits a barrel on the rerun it will still be a clean run if their first run was clean. Broken patterns will result in a no time on the rerun.

CIRCLING BARRELS / KNOCKED DOWN BARRELS

- Contestant is not allowed to circle the barrel during the race.
- In the event the barrel is circled during the race, a \$10 fine and will need to be paid before the contestant's next run and will be donated to the East Texas Angel Network.
- A down barrel will result in a no time; No money and/or prizes will be awarded for contestants with a down barrel.

PATTERN GUIDELINES

- Contestant will receive a no time if the horse falls or there is a broken pattern.
- The pattern must be in a cloverleaf pattern, running to the left or right, and horse must maintain forward motion at all times.
- Barrel patterns are on set measurements using laser beams. Barrels will also be marked and staked as well.
- Contestant may not circle once crossing the mouth of the alley or it will result in a disqualification.
- Once contestant breaks the timer eye, run will stand as is.

ALLEY WAY / HOLDING PEN

- Contestant is to be in the holding pen and ready when their drag begins.
- Contestant **MUST** enter thru the holding pen and will run out of arena thru an open alley.
- Not entering the arena from the holding pen will result in a disqualification for the round.

DRAGS

- Regular drags will occur every 5 names (Open Sweepstakes every 3 names) and big drag every 50 runs to keep the ground in excellent shape.
- Big drags will take approx. 15-18 minutes.

COMPETITION RACE (CONT'D)

DRAW ORDER

- Contestants entered in the average race, MUST run horses in the draw # assigned. Prizes and money are awarded based on the horse and contestant.
- Contestant must run in the draw position assigned. If a contestant runs out of order it will result in a no time.
- In the event contestant misses their run, they will receive a no time. Buy back runs are not allowed and no refunds will be given.

PHOTOGRAPHER / VIDEOGRAPHER

- J KKNIGHT MEDIA is the official 2024 Barrels for Angels event videographer and will be providing the live webcast & video action.
- TAYLOR MCCLAIN PHOTOGRAPHY is the official 2024 Barrels for Angels event photographer and will be capturing all of the arena action.
- No professional type photo or video cameras/lens will be allowed outside of those hired by the producer to take photos of anyone other than immediate family. Please be respectful of those hired by Lucky Lotto Events to bring great quality photographs.
- A flash will be used as needed for correct lighting inside the arena; No special circumstances will be given in regards to the flash.
- Videographer and photographer will capture action shots for each contestant and will be available for purchase.
- ***Please DO NOT take photos or videos of their monitors and/or computer displays unless permission is granted from the photographer or videographer. If you are caught doing this or posting "proof" or screenshot photos on Facebook or other social media obtained from our Barrels for Angels race, you will be required to purchase the photo, delete from social media or can be disqualified from the event. Please do not steal their work!***

VENDORS

- Weekend vendor fee of \$150 & \$200 per vendor space.
- Vendor booth spaces are 10 X 12. And 10 X 20
- Vendor may donate a silent auction item for the East Texas Angel Network and receive 10% discount on vendor fee.
- Vendor booth rental will be assigned and marked on site. Please make sure you are in your space.
- Vendor will need to provide all materials required for booth including any extension cords needed for electrical outlets.
- If a stall is needed, additional stall fees will apply in addition to vendor booth rental.
- Limited standard electrical outlets are available for use.
- Vendors may set up Friday, May 30, 2024 after 11:00am
- Vendor fees may be paid by mailing reservation form and check payable to Lucky Lotto Events.
- Vendor spaces are available on first come first serve basis.

SOCIAL MEDIA

- Our team/event is always open to listen to concerns. We respectfully ask for any questions/concerns please contact our staff IN PERSON and we will gladly discuss any issues.
- Negative comments, posts or disrespectful engagements on ALL social media from contestants, contestant's family/hauling partners or spectators in regards to the Lucky Lotto Barrels for Angels event, contestants, sponsors, workers, facilities or anyone/anything associated to the event will not be tolerated.
- If this takes place, producer has the right to disqualify the individual and request to leave the premises. Absolutely no refunds will be given.

CONDUCT OF ALL PERSONS ON SITE

- There will be no tolerance for excessive abuse of animals while on site at the Barrels for Angels event.
- In the event any situation arises during the Barrels for Angels event, please contact the producer.
- Producer has the right to correct any individual (contestant, family or spectator) from using excessive language or unacceptable behavior of any type.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in sight during the event.
- In the event any of the above actions continue after asked to refrain, contestant will be disqualified from the race and will be required to leave the facilities. If any contestants or any individual associated to contestant holds up the Barrels for Angels event for any reason, producer has the right to have said individuals removed by authorities if needed.
- Absolutely no refunds will be given if any instances occur.

PRODUCER HAS THE RIGHT TO MAKE FINAL DECISIONS AS NEEDED IF SITUATION OR CIRCUMSTANCES ARISE NOT COVERED IN ABOVE RULES
